The 15 organizations participating in this survey represent 944 places where projects are implemented, or humanitarian aid is distributed, with different territorial extension scopes.

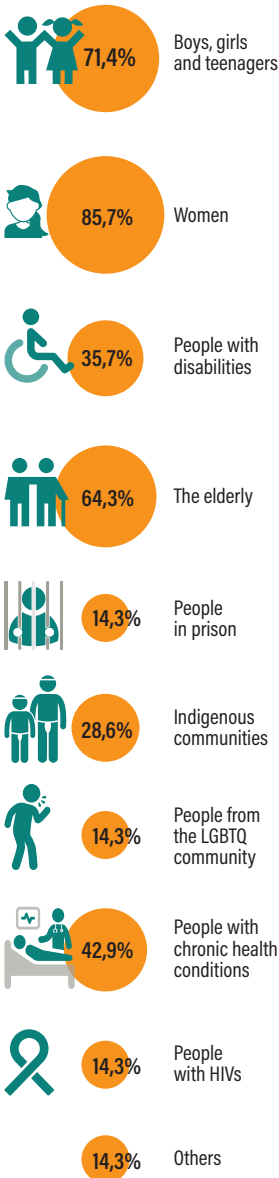

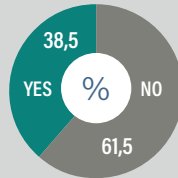


THOSE WE ASSIST

You may select more than one option.

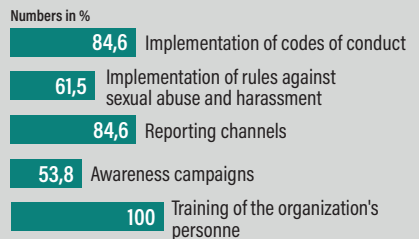


ACCOUNTABILITY AND PROTECTION



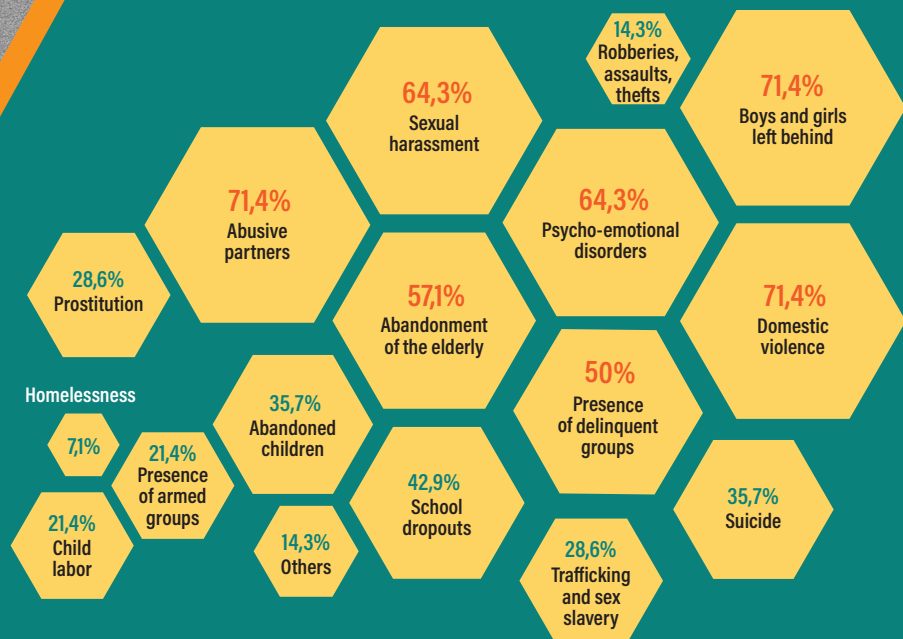
In the last year, you have received complaints from the communities about expectations for aid that your organization is unable to meet?

In the last year, what are the social problems that you have seen an increase in the communities where you work as a result of the humanitarian situation? You may select more than one option.

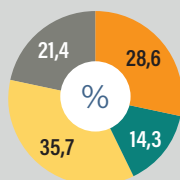


OPERATIONAL CONTINUITY

On aspects that enable operational continuity:

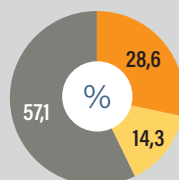
In the last year, funding for the humanitarian aid programs implemented by your organization.

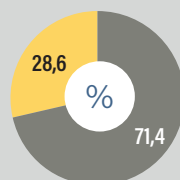
In the last year, has your organization suspended humanitarian aid operations?

Are the funds from the projects carried out in the international alliance provided a sufficient margin to cover operating costs, overhead, taxes, and security expenses?

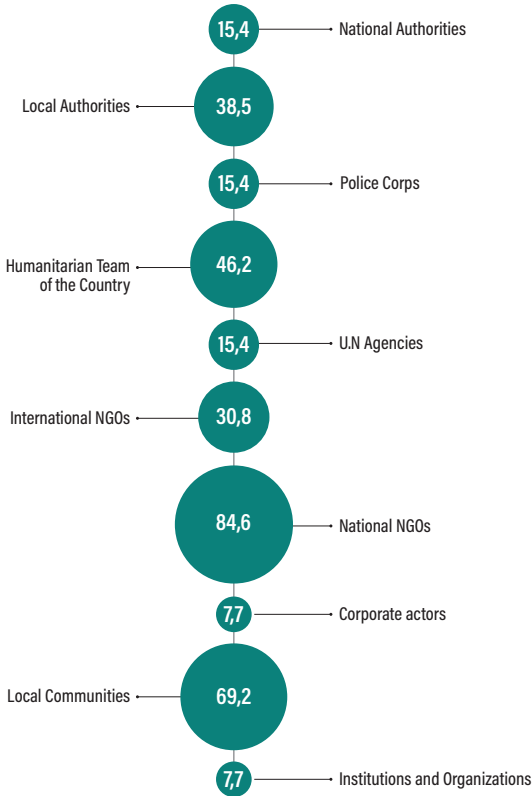

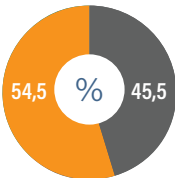
COORDINATION

According to last year, which of the of the following actors has your organization experienced an improvement in relations to coordination of humanitarian activities. You may choose more than one answer.

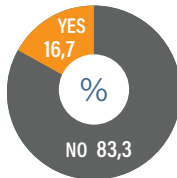


The coordination mechanisms by the international agencies have been, according to the already established ones.

- Has filled an empty void

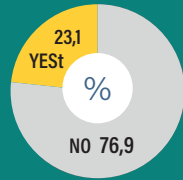

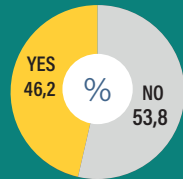


LOCALIZATION
