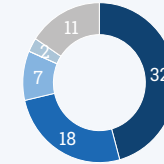

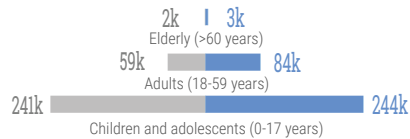

DISAGGREGATED BY SEX AND AGE



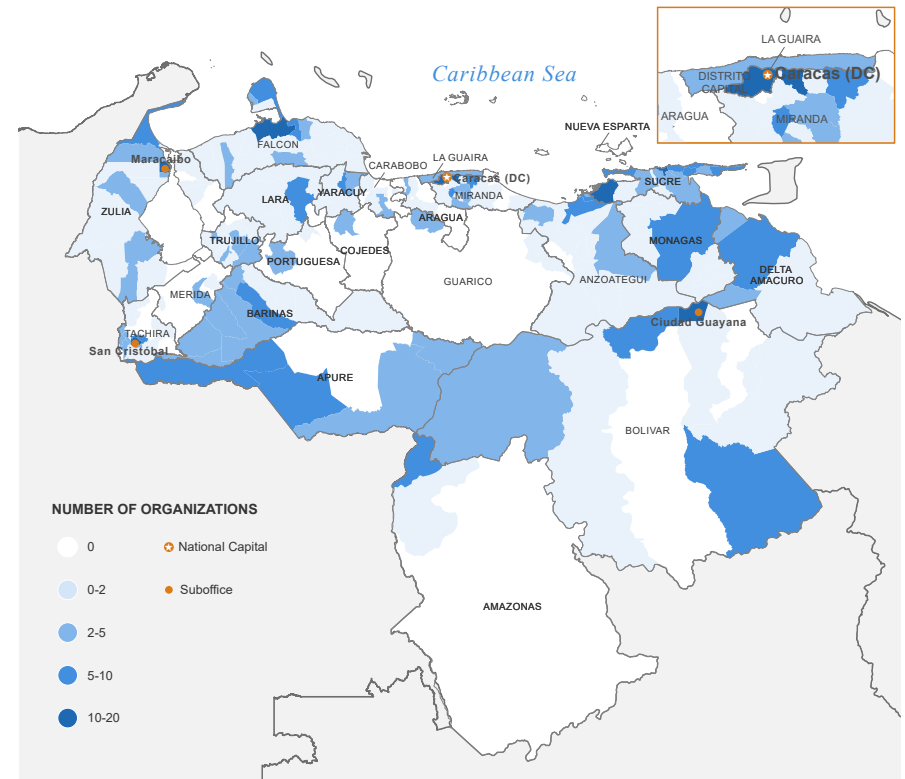

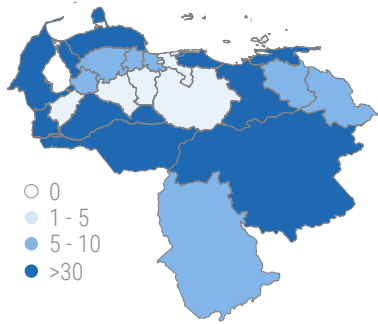

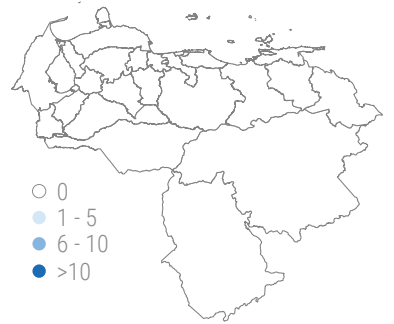

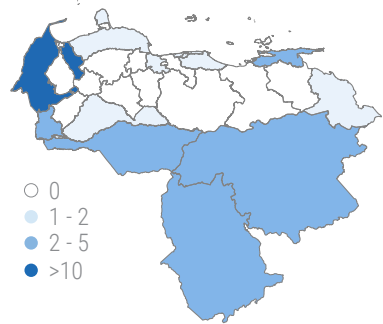

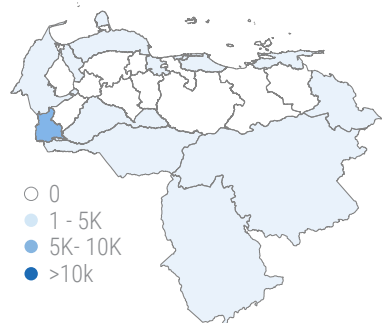

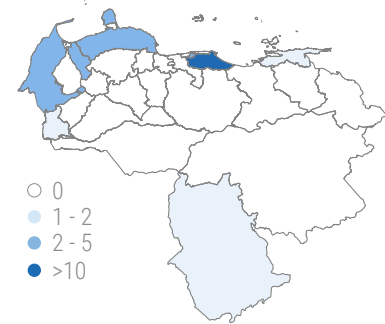

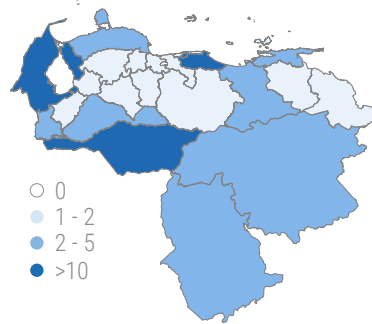

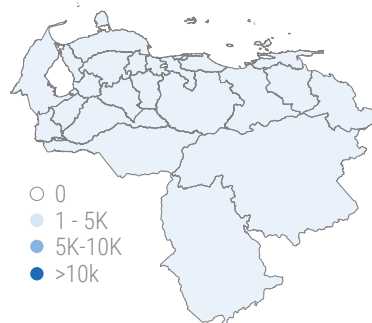


Gender Based Violence AoR

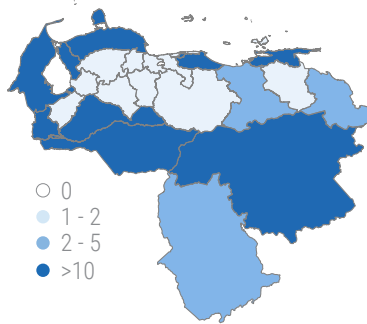

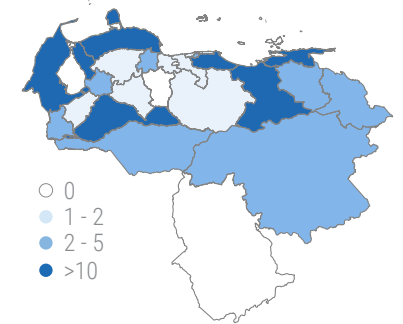

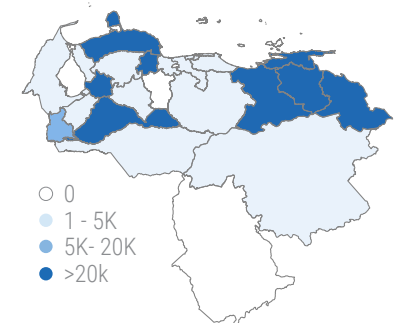
